

Courtesy Bus Information for Members & Guests

The WMLC provides a free Courtesy bus service to its Members and Guests. The bus services the local area including:

- Wynnum
- Wynnum North
- Wynnum West
- Manly
- Lota
- Wakerley
- some areas of Tingalpa and Hemmant

Bookings are essential and are to be made through the reception, either by phone or in person on the day of travel. Please give as much notice as possible to assist our drivers in keeping the scheduled services.

TIMES

The courtesy bus runs from 10am to close, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday and from 9am to close, Monday, Wednesday and Friday

Wynnum Area – on the hour **Manly Area** – on the half-hour

CHILDREN

Children aged 0 to 4 years are not permitted on the buses. Children 4 to 7 years are permitted but must be seated in an approved booster seat. You may bring your own booster seat or the club have a number of them available for use. Please notify the receptionist, at the time of booking, if you require the use of a booster seat.

GENERAL RULES

- The Pick-up address, time, member number, quantity of passengers, name and contact phone number, if requested, are to be provided
- Pick-ups and drop offs are in the local area. Suburbs include, Wynnum, Wynnum North, Wynnum West, Manly, Lota, Wakerley and some areas of Tingalpa and Hemmant. Generally speaking the bus doesn't go further than the Tingalpa Junction; however, exceptions can be made if just outside this area so ask one of our friendly Customer Service Attendants.
- We only pick-up or drop-off members to or from residential addresses, Wynnum Manly Workers Sport Club, Wynnum Central Shopping precinct (bus stops) and Wynnum Plaza.
- No alcohol, smoking or consumption of food are allowed on the bus
- Seatbelts must be worn at all times
- The Driver reserves the right to ask any patron to leave the bus for bad behaviour and or abusive or foul language
- The Driver has the discretion to decide the order of drop off and pick up
- Whilst every attempt will be made to pick up and drop off patrons at scheduled times, the club and driver reserve the right to change or delay times
- All patrons are requested to be patient and courteous with other patrons and the driver
Any member who has been refused service may be refused use of the courtesy bus
